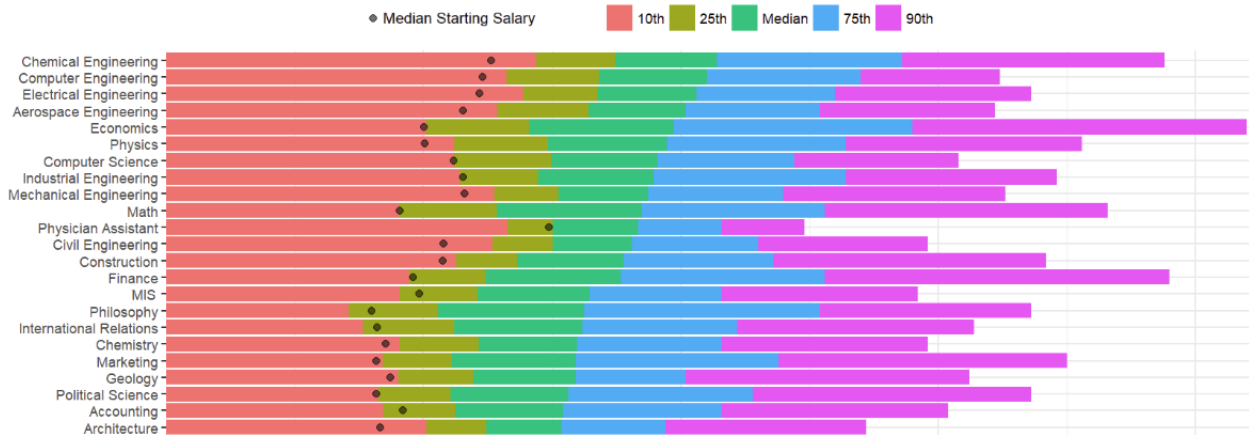




Which College Degrees Get the Highest Salaries?
